Sealed Bids for the Town of Zionsville 875 Sanitary Sewer Project will be received by the Town of Zionsville, ("Owner") at Town Hall, located at 1100 W. Oak Street, Zionsville, IN 46077, until 11:00 A.M., local time, on Friday, October 11, 2019 at which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read. Each Bid should be clearly marked "BID ENCLOSED for 875 Sanitary Sewer Project" on the outside of the envelope. Bids received after that time will be returned unopened. A conditional or qualified Bid will not be accepted.

Copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained through the Beam, Longest & Neff, LLC online Plan Room upon registration and payment of a non-refundable fee plus shipping and handling. The amount of this fee will vary depending on delivery and shipping costs. Payment by credit card is preferred. Partial sets of Bidding Documents are not available. Copies of any and all addenda which may be issued for this project shall be included with the purchased documents and shall be forwarded to all plan and specifications holders of record. Bids must be submitted on the forms found in the Bid Documents and shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the amount bid with satisfactory corporate surety or by a certified check on a solvent bank. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance and Payment Bonds in the amount of 100% of the Bid.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within sixty (60) days after the Bid opening.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids in whole or in part as specified in the solicitation when it is not in the best interest of the governmental body as determined by the purchasing agency in accordance with IC 5-22-18-2. The Owner also reserves the right to waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid, which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
