

INVITATION FOR PROPOSAL

Sealed Proposals for the Town of Zionsville 2020 Sewer Rehab – Clifden Pond Project will be received by the Town of Zionsville, ("Owner") at the office of Beam, Longest, and Neff, LLC. ("Engineer"), located at 8320 Craig Street, Indianapolis, IN 46250, until 10:30 A.M., local time, on December 4, 2020 at which time the Proposals will be publicly opened and read. Each Proposal should be clearly marked "PROPOSAL ENCLOSED FOR 2020 SEWER REHAB-CLIFDEN POND" on the outside of the envelope. Proposals received after that time will be returned unopened. A conditional or qualified Proposal will not be accepted.

An optional pre-bid meeting will be held virtually at 10:30 A.M., local time, on November 20, 2020. All prime contractors, subcontractors, utilities, small, minority or women business enterprises, and other interested parties are invited to attend. All interested parties please send an e

The Project, which is locally funded, will be constructed in one (1) contract division. In general, the work consists of providing all labor and material for the construction of 1500 LF of DR 11 HDPE sanitary force main.

Copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained through the Beam, Longest & Neff, LLC on-line Plan Room beginning at noon, local time, on November 4, 2020 upon registration and payment of a non-refundable fee plus shipping and handling. The amount of this fee will vary depending on the delivery and shipping costs. Payment by credit card is preferred. Partial sets of Bidding Documents are not available. Plans can be previewed and purchased at the on-line Plan Room, accessed by clicking the Plan Room tab at <http://www.b-l-n.com>. Copies of any and all addenda which may be issued for this project shall be included with the purchased documents and shall be forwarded to all plan and specifications holders of record. Expedited shipping of documents can be arranged at time of purchase.

Proposals must be submitted on the forms found in the Proposal Documents. The successful Proposer will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance and Payment Bonds in the amount of 100% of the Proposal.

Any Proposal may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Proposals, but no Proposer shall withdraw his Proposal within 60 days after the Proposal opening.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Proposals in whole or in part as specified in the solicitation when it is not in the best interest of the governmental body as determined by the purchasing agency in accordance with IC 5-22-18-2. The Owner also reserves the right to waive irregularities in any Proposal, and to accept any Proposal, which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
